

Preble County Council on Aging (PCCOA) Conditions of Participation

Agency Providers: These are the conditions for any provider who seeks to become, or to remain, a PCCOA Homemaking (HMK) provider.

- 1) **Service Provision:** Agency must be a Medicaid Certified Agency and comply with rules 173-39-02 and 173-39-02.8 of the Administrative Code.
- a. Attach latest Agency Audit Report along with Bid.
 - b. Attach proof of insurance with PCCOA as additional insured.
- c. Attach proof of certification with Medicaid

In addition to rule 173-39-02

(B)(1)(e)(iii) Taking the consumer to the provider's place of business. PCCOA does not allow transportation of consumer in personal vehicle.

In addition to rule 173-39-02.8

(B) (11): Documentation for service delivery must be submitted to PCCOA by Wednesday of each week.

Exception to rule 173-39-02.8

(C): One unit of service is one (1) hour.

- 2) Provider must be willing to provide service to clients throughout entire Preble County Area.
- 3) Bid shall include at least one of the following services: Homemaker Services, Personal Care, Respite Care and Companionship/Friendly Visitor Services.
